
Our Mission

We can now provide limited immigration legal services for low- to middle-income families to help with residency and naturalization application processes.

Our Madras staff and clients now have a new space to provide classes and events. For the first time ever, LCA Madras was able to host English classes, with plans to expand in 2023. Citizenship classes will also be offered in the new office.

Now we have the space to offer English and computer classes, cultural events and more privacy for our clients. We also rent the community room for family celebrations and community partner meetings and events.




Redmond Expansion in January 2023

Our Growing Latino Community


Latino Population Growth 1990-2020 Cities in Central Oregon




