
Mission: The mission of LCA is to empower our Latino families to thrive by creating opportunities for advancement and building bridges that unite and strengthen us all.

Bylaws: Our board of directors consists of at least 5 and no more than 15 members. The term of each director is 3 years. A quorum for decision-making will be a majority of the current members. Officers are elected annually and consist of President, Vice-president, Secretary and Treasurer. No director shall receive compensation.

Latino Community Association Board of Directors Duties & Responsibilities

LCA's Board focus is a blend of fundraising and policy - a governing board committed to supporting financial sustainability and developing policies that guide operational decisions. Board members of LCA understand that they are the stewards of the organization and accept the legal and fiscal responsibilities for the governance of the organization in accordance with LCA's by-laws and policies.





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Board Member Expectations

- 1. Ability to relate the mission/vision of LCA to others in a positive way.
- 2. Attend all board meetings, communicating to board any foreseeable absences.
- 3. Review the agenda and supporting materials ahead of time and request additional information.
- 4. Respond to board communications in a timely manner and follow through on given assignments.
- 5. Review the organization's financial statements (ask questions or request training for better clarity and understanding).
- 6. Support at least 1 board committee, attend training sessions and annual retreat.
- 7. Annually attend program-related events each year.
- 8. Ensure that LCA has adequate and well-managed resources.
- 9. Participate in fundraising and make a personally significant financial contribution.
- 10. Participate in recruitment of new board members.
- 11. Follow conflict of interest and confidentiality policies.
- 12. Refrain from making special requests of the staff.
- 13. Keep up-to-date on developments in the field.
